

Indoor Plant Care



Alocais Polly

Light: Bright Indirect light

Water: Soil should be moist, but not staurated.

Fertilizer: Every 2 to 3 weeks from March-September



Alocasia

Light: Medium to Bright Indirect Light

Water: Weekly in summer, Bi-Weekly in winter

Fertilizer: Spring & Summer months only; heavy on

Lime & Calcium



Calathea

Light: Partial Shade with Moderate Light Distilled

Water: Weekly in Warm Weather, Bi-weekly in winter

Fertilizer: Nitrogen rich in Spring & Mid-Summer only



Ficus Genseng

Light: Plenty of Indirect Sunlight

Water: Water thoroughly when dry. Prefers moist soil.

Fertilizer: Every two weeks from Spring until Fall



Ponytail Palm

Light: Happiest in Plenty of Sunlight

Water: Likes to be kept fairly dry

Fertilizer: Twice a month in Spring and Summer, Once a

month in Winter



Peperomia

Light: Prefers bright, indirect light

Water: Once weekly in Spring/Summer & Once in

Fall/Winter

Fertilizer: Liquid fertilizer every 2-4 weeks during

Spring/Summer-None in Winter



Maranta

Light: Prefers medium indirect light

Water: Likes to be moist, but not wet

Fertilizer: Year-round feeding, every 1-2 months



Money Tree

Light: Medium to Bright indirect light

Water: Prefers moist soil, not saturated.

Fertilizer: Every two months from Spring through

Summer



Philodendron

Light: Medium indirect light

Water: When top feels dry-do not overwater

Fertilizer: Every 1-3 months



Snake Plant-Sansevieria

Light: Do best in bright filtered light, but can adapt to low

light

Water: When soil is dry

Fertilizer: Every 3 months



Pothos

Light: Can survive in artificial light & low light

Water: Allow soil to dry between waterings

Fertilizer: Feed during Spring & Summer-every 2 weeks



Dracaena

Light: Will grow just about anywhere

Water: Let dry between watering

Fertilizer: Once or twice a year



Monstera or Swiss Cheese Plant

Light: Medium to bright indirect light

Water: Filtered water Every 1-2 weeks

Fertilizer: Encourage soil aeration, feed every 2 months



Haworthia Succulent

Light: Medium to low indirect light

Water: Water thoroughly then let drain and dry/repeat

Fertilizer: Half strength, feed only in Spring and Fall in

soil only; dormant in Summer



Echeveria Succulent

Light: Bright, Indirect light

Water: Water thouroughly & let dry between waterings

Fertilizer: Half strength, every 3 months



Sedum

Light: Full or Partial Sun

Water: Well drained soil, water when dry. No standing

water.

Fertilizer: Twice yearly-Spring and Fall



Kalanchoe

Light: Full or Partial Indirect Sun

Water: 2 times/week in well-drained soil

Fertilizer: Every 1-2 months with half strength liquid

fertilizer.
