Hoinsettia Plant Care



Poinsettia

Poinsettias are vibrant, festive plants known for their striking red, pink, or white bracts that surround small yellow flowers. A holiday favorite, they thrive in bright, indirect light and bring a cheerful touch to any space.

Bloom Time: Mid-winter, from November - December.

Temperature: Maintain a room temperature of 65–70°F. Avoid drafts, cold windows, or sudden temperature changes.

Light: Place in bright, indirect sunlight for at least 6 hours a day.

Water: Water when the top inch of soil feels dry. Ensure good drainage to prevent root rot—do not let the plant sit in water.

Fertilizer: Fertilize monthly with a balanced houseplant fertilizer.

Humidity: Prefer moderate humidity; avoid overly dry air.
